Diane's Pumpkin Soup

½ butternut pumpkin – chopped into small pieces

2 potatoes – chopped into small pieces

1 onion – thinly diced

1 carrot – thinly sliced

1tsp Chicken Stock

1 cup water

Salt and pepper

1tbsp sugar

Put all the vegetables, chicken stock and water into a pot, cook for about 30 minutes until soft. Add 1 tbsp of sugar stir. Puree mixture place into bowl, season to taste then garnish with parsley and a dollop of sour cream. Serve with a piece of crusty bread.
